- Logo must include the words:
  - Acadia's Centennial
  - o **1916 2016**
  - Celebrate our past! Inspire our future!
    - This slogan should be placed in such a way that it can be removed, depending on the size and contextual use of the logo
- See the Acadia National Park Centennial Logo Contest Creative Brief for additional design considerations.
- Entries must include:
  - Original artwork
  - Completed Entry Form
  - \$30 entry fee payable by check or money order made out to Friends of Acadia. Up to 3 designs may be submitted by one entrant per \$30 entry fee.
  - 3 color copies of each logo on white paper, with no name or identifying information on the page
  - CD with the logo in JPG, EPS, TIF, PDF, and PNG (color and black and white)
  - Color Palette (Pantone) and Font(s) used
  - o Entries should arrive in a sealed envelope
- Entries must be postmarked by February 28, 2014. Entries should be mailed or delivered to:

- The contest will be judged anonymously by a panel of Friends of Acadia and Acadia National Park staff.
- The winner of the logo contest will receive \$3,000 and will be announced via press release and on the Friends of Acadia website/social media.
- All entries become the property of Friends of Acadia.
- Board, staff, and immediate family members of Friends of Acadia may not enter the contest. Employees and immediate family members of Acadia National Park may not enter the contest.
- Entrants must be 18 years old.
